1. AMBrc Personal Transponders allowed -- AMB House Transponders available (limited quantity)
2. Pre-Reg online (pay on Race Day) helps racing begin sooner on Race Day
3. Allowed batteries = Nicd, NiMh, Hard Case Lipos (subject to class requirements)
4. Race Day Schedule:
  - 6:00 am Race Day online Pre-Reg ends
  - 8:15 am Race Day Registration opens
  - 10:00 am Race Day Registration closes
  - 10:20 am Drivers' Meeting begins
  - 10:30 am Racing begins
  - Be on time for each of your heats or forfeit
5. Fees = Normal Open Track Program Fees apply (watch or drive \$8 or \$6 )
  - + Class Entry Fees for Drivers: \$6 per class (Pre-Reg or Reg)

## ADDITIONAL CLASS NOTES

### \* **F-I (Class Rules are a work in progress.)**

Any 1/10 scale 2WD direct drive purpose-built F-I chassis (F103, F104, F109, HPI F10).

No hybrid cars...ie...pan car with a F-I body or pan car suspension.

Cars must be within the dimensions of the Tamiya F102/F103/F104 cars

F-I specific rubber or foam tires.

Tamiya type wheels only no pan car wheels. Realistic F1 bodies and wings with driver figure and head/helmet.

Realistic paint jobs would be cool also, but not required.

Making engine noises on the drivers stand allowed, laughing encouraged!

### \*\* **RWH GT**

**SPEC MOTOR / ESC:** Speed Passion Cirtix 17.5 Stock Combo Motor / ESC

**Body Rules:** Any realistic (real car) body qualifies, production or race.

No "performance" bodies allowed, such as Protoform makes.

IFS bodies are legal, but no cut-outs allowed for shock towers.

All bodies must be readily available from manufacturer (no prototypes).

Wings and supports used must be supplied with body (cut along cut lines or smaller).

\*\*\* **MINIMUM CAR WEIGHT** - Will lower when ROAR lowers.

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
